Parents and guardians across the globe choose between hundreds of child restraint devices wishing to guarantee the best level of safety for their children. Their decision is based on unclear ratings, price or design. They do so, since this is the only information available.

The Children Safety Initiative calls on establishing transparency with regards to children restraint systems. All the car seats, boosters and other devices are tested before they enter the market. However, once approval is granted, no information on their safety performance and test results is available.

Consumer's right to informed choice on child restraint systems market must be respected. Institutions responsible for testing and approving children restraint devices are in possession of safety test results. Companies producing children restraint devices are in possession of safety test results. Why is this information not available to parents or any customer?

The Children Safety Initiative is an open petition to ask for support for making devices safety tests results public. Our team reaches out to parents, consumers, regulatory bodies, standardization authorities and children restraint systems producers calling for action to establish transparency of the safety test results. The ultimate goal of the Children Safety Initiative is to launch European Citizens' Initiative amending the Consumer Rights Directive.
